Curtis graduated from Macomber-Whitney High School in 1976. During his 4 years in high school, he was one of the "GREATS" ! He received many awards and was named All-City in basketball. Curtis played college basketball at Cleveland State University, Bowling Green State University and Monroe Community College.

In 1983, Curtis joined The Toledo Police Department as a police officer and retired in 2015. During his 32 years of service, he became an accident investigator, he was a member TPD's Honor Guard and the African American Patrolmen's League.

Curtis confessed Christ as his Lord and Savior and was baptized at The Rock of Praise Church of God in Christ, where Eugene Harris, Sr is the Pastor. Curtis was a choir member and active on numerous committees within the church. First Lady Harris says , "he was instrumental in getting things done. He was a true leader".
