



Daisy M. Neyland

January 23, 1931 - September 8, 2022

Daisy was born in Centerville, MS to the late Robert Sr. and Naomi Seals. She is survived by three brothers: Owsly, Frank, and Jimmie Seals, and preceded in death by her brother, Robert Jr.

Daisy married (the late) McLaurin Neyland Sr on May 15, 1951. She was preceded in death by McLaurin on July 9, 2013, to whom she was married for 62 years.

After graduating high school, she pursued a secretarial career, but found she was more passionate about the creative world of cosmetology. She graduated as a licensed cosmetologist with honors.

Daisy excelled in cooking skills and signed on as lead cook at Howard Johnson's, moved on to the Toledo Racetrack, and finally the Toledo Airport where she created the "Daisy Burger" – named after her and was one of the top menu items requested. Retiring in 1972 to rear her growing family but always eager to learn, she mastered classes as a seamstress, in hat making, ceramics, and floral design, and had a well-known, thriving business for her homemade cakes. From designing and baking elegant masterpiece tiered wedding cakes, memorable holiday and special occasion cakes, she became the go-to baker for many in and out of state.

Her home was the central meeting place for warm, elaborate holiday get-togethers for family and extended family.

Daisy dedicated her life to serving God, her family, and people. She fellowshiped with the Wabash St. C.O.G.I.C. under the pastorate of Elder M. H. Hawkins in 1952 who later moved and established Zion C.O.G.I.C. Her auxiliary positions included: treasurer of the Mother's Board, member of the Missionary Board, the Sewing Circle, and as a substitute Sunday School teacher. As a key member of the bereavement committee at Zion, she assisted with meal planning and food preparation for bereaved families. Called "Mom" by many, she remained a loyal member of Zion C.O.G.I.C. which later became New Life C.O.G.I.C. under the pastorate of Bishop Edward T. Cook.

Preceded in death by her husband, McLaurin, and son, Bernard, she leaves behind a legacy in her children: McLaurin Jr., Kathleen, Sandra, Michael, Denise, Vincent, Gwendolen (Ron), and Eliana; grandchildren: Elissa, Jamarr, and Jayden; great-grandchildren: Kayla and Ashli; along with a host of nieces, nephews and other relatives and friends. As a wife and mother, she was deeply devoted and dedicated to her family unto death.
