Edith A. Gholston, 92, passed away October 30, 2014, at Clarksburg Continuous Care in Clarksburg, WV. Born in Monongah, WV, she came to the Toledo area in 1955. She was a math specialist with the Toledo Public Schools for 32 years, retiring in 1987. She worked as a teacher at Gunkel and King Schools as well as Assistant Director of Head start and Principle of Collingwood Learning Center.
