Rev. Elijah S. Hicklin, 88 went to be with the Lord on September 20, 2009.

Rev. Hicklin was born in Ferriday, Louisiana to the union of Elijah and Amanda Hicklin and the brother of Joseph Hicklin, all who preceded him in death. Rev. Hicklin was a veteran of WWII serving in the branch of the U.S. Army. After been discharged in 1946, he moved to Toledo and various jobs such as Wash Clark Automotive and Rossford Ordinance just to name a few.

Rev. Hicklin attended Southern University in Baton Rouge, La, American Baptist College in Nashville, TN where he received his B.A. and M.Div., University of Toledo and Winebrenner Theological Seminary in Findlay, OH.
