On the eighth month, fourth day, 1946, in Adams Township, now Toledo, Ernest was born to Daniel Boose and Ann Dice. He passed away on January 15, 2024 at Toledo Hospital. He was the fifth among six children and the sole surviving sibling. He was a proud Libbey High School Cowboy and played on the football team.

Over their 53 years of marriage, Ernest and his wife Joan lovingly raised their children: son Kevin (Song) Metress, Angelyn, Michelle, and Kimberly. Additionally, they were blessed with three grandchildren Kelly (Angelica), Erica (Sloan), and Danielle.

A military veteran, he dedicated three years of service during the Vietnam War as an Airman in the Navy aboard the USS Constellation (CV-64).
