Eudell loved going on road trips with friends and family fishing trips barbecuing and entertaining his family and friends along with telling his corny jokes and stories.

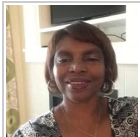
Left to cherish his memories is his loving wife Cathrine Cartridge-Patrick
