On October 21, 2020, George P. Lee, Jr. heard the call of the Master's voice and left this earthly body to be with God in Heaven. He was born October 23, 1950, at Mercy Hospital, Toledo, OH to the late George P. Lee, Sr. and Leona Lee (Simmons).

At an early age he confessed his salvation in Christ and united with Calvary Baptist Church, and was baptized under the pastorate of the late Dr. L. H. Newsom. He attended Jesup W. Scott High School where he was a member of the wrestling team and marching band. Upon graduation in 1968, he joined the United States Navy and was honorably discharged in 1971.
