Henry Tyson was born on February 15, 1935, in Moultrie, Georgia, to the late Hillard and Lucille Tyson. He passed away on April 6, 2026, surrounded by his loving wife, Marsha, and his family, including his children and grandchildren.

Henry served in the United States Army as a lineman beginning in 1956 for two years and continued his service in the Reserves until December 1962. He married the love of his life, Marsha Williams, on July 21, 1961. They were married for nearly 65 years.

Henry was a devoted member of Parkwood Seventh-day Adventist Church, where he faithfully served as a deacon until his health no longer permitted him to do so.

Throughout his life, Henry prioritized his family, providing for them while cultivating a deep love for the outdoors. Although he completed only an eighth-grade education initially, he later returned to school to earn his GED. He then attended Davis Business College, where he obtained his associate degree, an accomplishment he was very proud of.

Henry took great pride in his yard, nurturing beautiful flowers and vegetables and showcasing his exceptional gardening skills. Elder George Cross can attest to the sweetness of the many watermelons he grew. He also had seven

peach trees that produced some of the sweetest peaches. Henry's life was a testament to his faith and to God's many blessings.

Henry was preceded in death by his son, Henry Jr.; seven brothers, Mack, Dimp, Stanley, Charlie, Willie, William, and Eddie Tyson; and six sisters, Sarah Jordan, Susie Mobley, Josephine Tyson, Rutha Mae Brooks, Thelma Brooks, and Bessie Hunt.
