Jamesetta Hopson Royster was born on August 11, 1944 in Toledo, Ohio to the union of James Cleo and Winnie Lee (Lawhorn) Hopson. She departed this life on Monday, June 10, 2024 at Hospice of Northwest Ohio surrounded by family. She was preceded in death by both parents James Cleo and Winnie Lee Hopson.
