Mrs. Jane Evelyn Austin was born September 29, 1951 in Hope, Arkansas to Mr. William and Bessie Powell. She departed this life quietly on Tuesday morning August 10, 2021 in the Cleveland Clinic, Cleveland, Ohio at the age of 69 years old.

She was always a very friendly and outgoing person who was loved by all who knew her. She touched many lives and loved children always finding time for them.
