John Quinn was born in Toledo, Ohio on May 28, 1948 to the late Johnnie and Estella Quinn, the youngest of five siblings.

He attended Sherman Elementary School and went on to graduate from Jesup W. Scott High School in 1966. In 1969, he received his certification as a Surgical Technician, which proved to be one of his callings, as he had a long, successful, career, in that field for 52 years at St. Vincent Medical Center.

Brother Quinn accepted Christ at an early age at the New Light Baptist Church. He had been a member of Eastern Star Missionary Baptist Church, since the Church was organized, in 1961. Under the leadership of Pastor John W. Williams, Brother Quinn was a Tither, active in the teaching arms of the Church, attending Bible Study and Sunday School regularly, Vice President of the Presidential Club, and member of the Voices of Eastern Star Choir, where he served as the Organist for numerous years. His dedication to the position is to be admired and is evidence of his commitment to Christ, his Church and his Pastor.

Brother Quinn loved attending Church, spending time with family, shopping, skating and traveling, in his later years. He had a great sense of humor and enjoyed this life until departing on Sunday, February 7, 2021 in his home.

He was preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Curtis and Howard; and sister, Beneva Cole. Surviving are his brother, Otis Quinn, sister-in-law, Joyce Quinn, many nieces, nephews, a host of other relatives, Church family and friends.

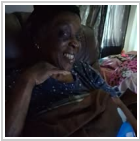
“ John Earl,
