Larshall (Brown) Lee, 74, affectionately known as "Sister", of Belleville, MI, passed away Sunday December 14, 2025, in the Regency Rehabilitation Center, Canton, MI after suffering a long-term illness. She was born on September 3, 1951, in Toledo, OH to the union of Mr. and Mrs. James and Evelyn Brown.

She was the only girl of eleven children, and twin to Marshall. She was preceded in death by both parents and 6 brothers. She was a member of the Angelic choir; she enjoyed music and singing. She is a 1969 graduate of Jesup W. Scott, she was a member of the Symphonic choir at Scott high school, and a member of the Upward bound program at University of Toledo.

Larshall enjoyed traveling to visit her family, she enjoyed cooking, playing games telling jokes, and singing. After working for Jeep for some years, she had her only daughter Kimberly in 1970. She was a loving mother and grandmother. She relocated to Michigan in 1990, where she met the love of her life. She was united in holy matrimony to Curtis Lee on January 2, 1992. She was employed at Michigan Habilitation and Learning for a few years

before employment at Majors AFC assisted living home. Due to health issues and suffering from an aneurysm, she retired. After retirement, she bought a food truck "Lee's Eatery" and poured her passion for cooking on the grill, specializing in ribs and her special sauce. When that became too much, she sold her truck and traveled, visiting family and enjoying life. She became a member of the Mt. Hermon Baptist church, where she was an actively involved member; she was a member of the choir, enjoyed her church sisters; circle of women who brunch together, shopped together, and served the community together. She enjoyed servitude and making people feel loved, she was always willing to help someone, she never met a stranger; she was just like her dad, Papa Brown. Larshall loved her family, her church family, and her friends. Her gentle and loving spirit will be greatly missed by many that loved her.
