



## Lee Liddell

Lee Liddell Sr. 87, passed away March 1, 2012 at Hospice of Northwest Ohio Detroit Avenue.

Born in Grenada, Miss, he was a graduate of Booker T.?? Washington High School in Memphis TN and attended University of Toledo and Toledo Barber College. After enlisting in the service during World War II he became a member of the prestigious Tuskegee Airmen (617th Bombardment Squadron). After his honorable discharge, he returned to Toledo to open one of the First African American barbershops in the city. For 46 years, he owned and operated "Liddell's Barbershop" at 1082 Dorr St. and later 921 Junction until his retirement in 1996. His wife, initially also a barber, was many times at his side serving their customers. Over the years, Mr. Liddell provided his services to many who could not afford to pay, especially children at the start of the school year. Always civic minded, he attended the 1963 march on Washington and was a member of the Southern Poverty Law Center and the NAACP. He was also a member of Composite Lodge #108, AF & AM. A longtime member of Third Baptist Church, he has served on the Men's Council, the Senior Usher Board and was 2006 Father of the Year. A devoted family man he shared 7 years of courtship and 64 years of marriage with wife Euneda Golliday Liddell and was father to their four children. Mr. Liddell was preceded in death by two brothers Charles and James Liddell.
