Mrs. Maggie Ruth Parker of Maumee, Ohio departed this life peacefully on November 16, 2017

Maggie was born to B.J. and Jennie Mae Foster on August 26, 1938 in Fosters, Alabama. She

was the second of three children born to that union. The family moved to Ohio during the Great

Migration, late in 1946. She began her formal education in Toledo, Ohio, graduating from

Harriet Whitney High School as a master seamstress. She continued her education at The

University of Toledo. Maggie's career highlights included her position as Director of Head Start

Transportation under the Toledo Public Schools and then Economic Opportunity Planning

Association of Greater Toledo, from which she retired in the early 1980s. She served as a

member of the Lucas County Metropolitan Housing Authority Community Board of Directors,

which allowed her to assist first-time home-owning families.

Baptized as a Jehovah's Witnesses more than 45 years ago, she had a strong love for Jehovah

God and served him well. Maggie had an amazingly special way of bonding with family and friends especially over her home cooked meals.
