NORMA ELIZABETH PRICE PASSED AWAY PEACEFULLY AT HOME JULY 19th AT THE AGE OF 89

SHE WAS BORN IN NASHVILLE TENNESSEE ON MAY 4, 1931 TO GEORGE MILLER AND MARGARETTE (WATSON) MILLER (BOTH DECEASED). SHE HAS ONE SIBLING, HER SISTER JUNE (BARROW) LAMBE OF TAMPA FLA. NORMA RELOCATED TO PONTIAC MICHIGAN AT THE AGE OF 12 AND ATTENDED SCHOOL THERE. SHE MARRIED EDDIE PRICE IN 1953 AND MOVED TO TOLEDO, OHIO. TO THEIR UNION WERE BORN (4) CHILDREN. MARGARET PRICE (DECEASED), NEDRA L. JOHNSON, LINDA M. PRICE, AND HELSA A. PRICE OF TOLEDO, OHIO. NORMA WORKED FOR OVER 30 YEARS AS A NURSES AID AT ST. VINCENTS HOSPITAL. SHE WORKED PRIMARILY IN PEDIATRICS AS SHE LOVED CHILDREN AND WANTED TO HELP THEM. NORMA WAS KNOWN FOR HER KINDNESS AND GENTLE DEMEANOR. SHE LOVED HER FAMILY AND ALWAYS TRIED TO SUPPORT THEM IN ANY WAY. PARTICULARLY, WHEN IT CAME TO COOKING. SHE LOVED TO COOK AND SOUL FOOD WAS HER SPECIALTY. SHE ALSO LOVED TO DRESS UP AND WEARING A NICE HAT WAS HER JOY. SHE WAS A FAITHFUL AND DEDICATED JEHOVAH'S WITNESS SINCE HER BAPTISM IN THE 1950'S.
