



## Supt. Emeritus William Clifton Terry

William Clifton Terry, 86, passed away on October 3, 2014, at Genesis Health Care in Perrysburg, Ohio. William was known by all affectionately and respectfully as "Elder Terry," as well as "Bishop" by his family, and was born April 30, 1928, in Memphis, Tennessee to the union of John and Lillian Patterson Terry.

Upon graduation from high school, William volunteered and joined the U.S. Army and later served also in the U.S. Air Force. He was honorably discharged from both armed services. William moved to Cleveland, Ohio where he was employed as a bus driver with the Cleveland Transit System. He was employed there for 39 years, retiring in 1972 to assume the pastorate at the Mt. Zion Church of God in Christ, Canton, Ohio. He served as Senior Pastor of Mt. Zion for 39 years, retiring and becoming Pastor Emeritus in 2011.
